Agroecology involves the application of ecological principles to understand and sustainably manage agro-systems, supporting the delivery of ecosystem services. It is a holistic approach that combines ecology, culture, economy and society to support agricultural production, the environment and communities. The heterogeneity and local specificity of agro-ecological practices has not yet led to the adoption of a specific protocol that defines what is an agroecological approach with its relative farming practices. These are in fact adapted to the diversity and specificity of each agro-ecosystem.

To study and promote agroecology in viticulture some questions are coming of age:

- What defines agroecology in viticulture?
- What operational protocols characterise it?
- Which methods and indicators could we use to quantify the ecosystem and social benefits of agroecology?
- What promotes social acceptance of the agroecological approach?

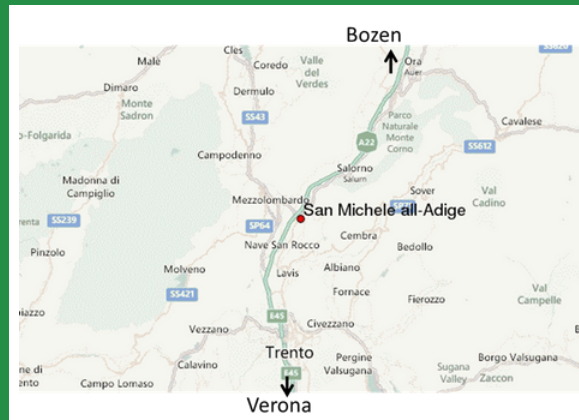
CYCLE OF SEMINARS
